

First Baptist Church Scholarship

The First Baptist Church Scholarship has been set up to financially assist a graduating High School senior who is active in the First Baptist Church of Osawatomie, in furthering their education.

The award shall be given to graduating High School Senior(s) who are active in church activities and will be attending an accredited college or vocational school in the fall.

The selection committee shall consist of active members of the First Baptist Church.

The selection committee will determine the amount and number of scholarships to be awarded based on available funds.

The presentation of this award shall be made at the annual Frank Elliot Awards assembly and at an appropriate time during the morning worship service at the First Baptist Church. The committee will also ask the recipient each year to attend the banquet the following year to assist in giving out the scholarship, if they are available to attend. This in no way will keep them from receiving their scholarship if they are not able to attend.

The scholarship shall be awarded on October 1 on evidence of full-time attendance at an approved school. If the award exceeds \$200 per individual, one half shall be awarded on or about October 1 and the second one-half on or about February 1.

Selection Criteria in order of importance:

1. Active participation in activities of the First Baptist Church of Osawatomie.
2. Financial need.
3. High School academic performance.
