Information: The Miami County Sheriff's Office Cops For Tots program began in 1995 as a tribute dedicated to the memory of Sheriff Ken Davis. The program serves hundreds of children each year in Miami County. Not only does it make special Christmas memories through the Angel Tree program it also provides assistance to children throughout the year as well as helping to stock the local food pantries. We are excited to add to this organization, a scholarship program for graduating seniors in Miami County.

Purpose: This scholarship will be awarded to a senior with a strong community service work ethic.

Criteria: The applicant shall be a graduating senior, intend to continue his/her education at a two or four year college, technical school, or university, have a 2.0 GPA, be a Miami County resident, and have a **strong** background in community service.

Amount: This will be a one-time scholarship of \$250 to be used for tuition, fees, books or other required course-related expenses. This scholarship will be awarded as a check to the school at the time of the student's enrollment.

Submit: Please submit completed application, 2 reference letters and an official transcript.

Deadline: This completed application along with the other requirements needs to be returned to your high school counseling department by 3:30pm, February 16, 2016.
