

Nada Thoden Memorial Scholarship

Miami County Quilters Guild

Application Deadline March 20

The Miami County Quilters Guild, organized in 1979-80 for the purpose of stimulating interest in quilts and quilt making, will award a \$500 scholarship annually for a Miami County resident pursuing a Family & Consumer Science related major and career. If no applicant pursuing a FACS related major and career apply, the scholarship funds will be held for the next year awards. The scholarship award will be made directly to the college for the selected student after receipt of enrollment is received.

Nada Thoden was a former County Extensionist for both Miami and Johnson County,KS.

In 1979, she organized a group of Miami County residents with an interest in quilt making. From that group the Miami County Quilters Guild grew. Nada was devoted to promoting the art of quilt making, teaching beginner's classes in the Quilt Guild until 2013. Besides being the organizing force behind the creation of the Quilt Guild, teaching beginner's quilting classes, and establishing an annual quilt show, Nada served as President of the Quilt Guild in 2008 and 2009 and was the show featured quilter in 2012.

- 2 letters of reference (at least one from school personnel)
