A Message from the Principal

Tardy Policy @ Trojan

Please note the tardy policy at Trojan. It reads:

A student is counted tardy if they report to their classroom after 8:15am. 6 tardies per semester will be accepted before the student is required to serve a detention after school or during school hours. A call will be made to notify parents of the detention, and the parents will be required to provide transportation for the student after the detention. After 12 tardies, a report will be made to DCF for truancy. Appointments due to doctor, dentist, counseling sessions, or other medically related issues would not count as a tardy if a note from the medical or social facility is presented to the school.
